Wild Cards and How They are Used

- Ancestry.com offers **wild card** searching capability as well when searching any online databases. Wild cards are special symbols that are used in searching to represent some number of unknown letters in a word. Ancestry uses both the asterisk (*) and the question mark (?).

Warning: Wild card searching is for ancestry.com only-- not for Google searching.



Wild Card Examples

- A search for **fran*** will return hits on words like **Fran, Franny, Frank, Frannie, or Frankie.**
- A search for **Johns?n** will return both **Johnsen** and **Johnson.**
- The query **Johann*** will search for **Johann** and **Johannes.**
- A query for **Smel*er** will search for **Smeltzer** and **Smelzer,** among others.
- You can put a wild card first, such as ***son** or **?athew** to catch all spellings and variations.
- Either the first or last character must be a non-wild card character. For example, **Han*** and ***son** are okay, but not ***anso*.**
- Names must contain at least three non-wild card characters. For example, **Ha*n** is okay, but not **Ha***



Adjusting the Form of the Name You Enter

- Sometimes less is more. Ancestry.com leaves names as they appeared on the original document. Sometimes that was only with a first initial. Try varying your search methods. For example, the name **James Bruny** may be in records by first name as **Jim**, **Jas.**, **Jimmy**, and **J**, and by last name as **Bruny**, **Bruney**, and so forth. You will want to vary your searching methods to make sure you do not miss valuable records.

Selecting the Soundex Spelling Option

- An additional tool to take into account possible spelling variations or errors (whether recorded by the original record-takers or the indexers of original documents) is the **Soundex**. This filter is designed to display results for all names which have somewhat similar pronunciation. To take advantage of this feature, check the box next to "Exact matches only" and an option will appear to change the Spelling option on a search template from Exact to **Soundex** or on a few pages click on the box next to the word **Soundex** (depending on where on our site you are selecting the **Soundex** feature).

Searching with Keywords

- Often, more data is found in an original record than the number of fields provided by a search template would indicate. If you do have additional information, you can enter this data in the **keyword** field in order to refine your search results. Using the keyword field like this is especially helpful if your ancestor has a common name and you are getting more results than you can easily review.
